

Hexi Blanket



Sizes: Baby Lap Throw

Dimesions: 63cm x 77cm 91cm x 119cm 126cm x 147cm

MATERIALS

Yarn: Fibra Natura Cottonwood (105m/50g) or any 8ply/DK weight yarn

We used 5 colours, but you can use as many as you like.

Hook: 3.50 - 4mm or size to obtain gauge

Gauge: Each hexagon measures about 7cm from side to side and weighs approximately 3.6g

Materials: Yarn needle for weaving in ends and joining

Note: This pattern is written using UK crochet terminology.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch chain


1tr work 1 treble

sts stiches

sl st slip stitch

R1 round 1

CHART



PATTERN

Make your hexagons using the chart or the written instructions below.

Rnd 1: ch6 to start, in first chain work (2tr, 2ch) five times, 1tr, sl st into 4th ch from hook, sl st into chain space. 6 clusters made.

Rnd 2: ch5, (1tr in chain space from previous row, 1tr in next 2 sts, 1tr in chain space, ch2) five times, 1tr in chain space, 1tr in next 2 sts, sl st in 3rd chain, sl st into chain space.

Rnd 3: ch4, (1tr in chain space from previous row, 1tr in next 4 sts, 1tr in chain space, ch2) five times, 1tr in chain space, 1tr in next 4 sts, sl st in 3rd chain or use invisible join to close.

Leave a 25-30cm tail to sew motifs together.

For a neat edge on your motifs, you can join the end of your final round for each colour using an Invisible Join, like in this video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=S3694llYN5 w




Continue to make the number of hexagons in your chosen colours using the following as a guide, or use whatever colours you like!

Col A	26	54	102
Col B	26	54	101
Col C	14	35	55
Col D	14	35	55
Col E	14	35	55
Total	94	213	368

ASSEMBLY

Assemble the motifs with the following layout.



	Baby	Lap	Throw
Motifs across	9	13	18
Rows high	11	17	21

Weave in any ends that are left, then wet block to finish.

Joining

Using your darning needle, join your hexagons together with the tails using Whip Stitch. We like to join two sides of each motif using it's own tail.
