TOY MATERIALS:

- **Plush yarn**: 2 skeins of main color and half of additional color. If you have a 4mm crochet hook, you need 2.5 skeins of main color and one half of additional color;
- Sewing thread for eyes and nose in black, white and blue for the eyes and pink for the nose and to sew
 the ears and tail;
- 3mm or 4mm crochet hook necessary to obtain gauge
- 10 discs for attaching paws and head, diameter 3.5 cm (If you have velvet thread) and 4.5 cm (If you have plush thread).
- Counter pins 5 pieces (T-shaped) or 10 pieces of 0-shaped.
- For each rabbit I used several cotter pins: 5×28 in the shape of 0, (10 pieces), in the shape of τ 2.5-28, you can use 3.2-32 (5 pieces) washers 10 pieces (I I have a diameter of 7 mm). (If the toy has plywood discs, then you need archers, if you have plastic discs, you can't use them. You can buy them from a craft store.
- round nose pliers. You can use plastic joints 3.5 cm for the velvet rabbit and 4.5 cm for the plush rabbit (5 pieces);
- Fiberfill for stuffing
- needle, marker, scissors

CLOTHING MATERIALS:

- cotton yarn: 3 skeins of main color for the velvet rabbit 1 ball of additional color
- Buttons (15mm buttons, you can use the buttons you like;
- 2 mm crochet hook;
- If you want to decorate clothes with mouse faces, then you need safety eyes (9mm) for boots and safety eyes (11mm) for cape, pink thread for mouse faces.
- · Thread for sewing buttons,
- Needle
- Scissors.

"Cross" shape

You make magic ring with plush yarn otherwise because the yarn is bulky. You can do: 2 ch, in the second stitch make 6 sc, join sl st with in the first stitch, and the magic ring is ready.

I make it in this "Cross" shape, because that way the plush yarn looks prettier.

Plush yarn: Plush yarn is very soft and smooth the crochet hook glides on and the crochet process is a pleasure. The yarn is quite bulky, so toys are made quickly. But there are some nuances! When you cut the yarn, leave a longer end.

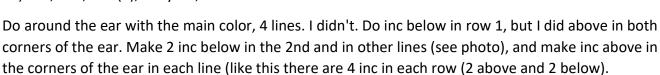

FACE DECORATION - SHAPING THE FACE:

Set the pins in places where there are eyes and nose. Place the pin between rounds 16 and 17 for the nose, then take 2 more pins and skip 5 stitches to the sides and set with pins one line up (it's for the eyes).

Insert one more pin (see photo, the pin is white).

Put the needle in this place, move it to the left,

where there is the pin for the eye,

pull the needle, miss a stitch to the left

and pull the needle to the white pin, fasten off.

If you want, you can repeat and shape.

We do the same with the other side (forming the second eye).

Then put the needle in the place where there is a nosepin, pull the thread over the head then hold it close to the white pin, finish off, so we made the rabbit cheeks, we tie the threads.

Sew the nose over the cheeks.

Sew the eyes above the cheeks, there are 3-4 points distance between the eyes.

So you can glue eyelashes and eyelids or sew them (I have "Vita" "Coco")

The head is ready.

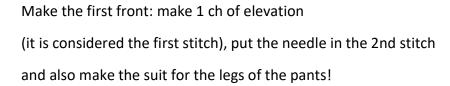

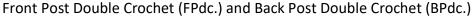

THEN MAKE SLEEVES

Join the yarn in the middle of the sleeve at the bottom, make 1 ch (crochet, as in the pant legs), around, I was 38 sc. Make sleeves 17 rounds and switch to additional color. Make the rib as you did the legs of the pants the first row - dc, and the second row –







THEN MAKE THE CAVA AND CAPE:

Join the yarn in the front right corner above, crochet along the armhole for the second front, then make 1 chain, turn and continue crocheting towarows the bottom (6 stitches together), continue to crochet on the right front corner, make 3 sc, then turn on the cover.













Start crocheting the cover:

Make the 1st row 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc.... and so on. crochet with a ch from elevation to cover, we will doin rounds 4 and 7, 1 inc after each 5 stitches, on the 8th row we will do until the walls of the cape join above the rabbit head, I had 34 rounds.

Sew the cover to your sc edges.







Now let's crochet around the cape.

Gather the yarn where it started at the front
On the left, crochet along the cover and
cava, then we will make 3 sc together and
crochet to the end of the row.

The second line we will do in the same way, but we must make holes for the buttons on one side of the pit, we will make 3 holes for the buttons. I did like this:

from the bottom of the armhole 3 sc, then 5 ch, skip 2 stitches, put the needle in the 3rd stitch, make 8 sc, 5 ch, skip 2 stitches, Place the needle in the 3rd stitch, make 8 sc, 5 ch, join with the beginning.











Hide all the threads, cut them, sew them buttons, the suit is ready.

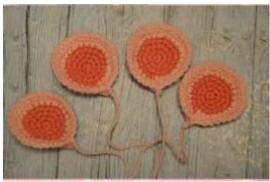
